

# Invitation to an information meeting

#### We will do the following work:

- 1. replace the main entrance access ramp, staircase and concrete slab
- 2. improve outdoor lighting at the main entrance
- 3. modernize the lobby
- 4. add railings to the access ramp behind the building
- 5. redo the concrete sidewalk on the left side of the building, which will be a little narrower but up to code
- 6. replace the roof
- 7. redo the landscaping in front of the building



# An information and consultation meeting was held in December 2022.

- at **meetings**
- Around 20 people attended this meeting.
- We informed you about the upcoming work.
- We consulted you about certain elements. You decided on:
  - dark grey concrete for the entrance
  - a vegetable garden on the right side of the entrance and plants on the left side
  - two benches in front of the building, one under the entrance roof and the other at the bottom of the access ramp near the sidewalk

## What you need to do

- 1. **Use the temporary entryways.** First, we will set up temporary entryways. Then we'll do the work in the main entrance. People using wheelchairs or walkers will be able to safely enter and exit the building from the back.
- 2. **A temporary intercom** will be installed at the entrance on the left side of the building. Your visitors will be able to use this intercom during the work in the main entrance.
- 3. **Stay outside the safety perimeter** of the site to avoid accidents.
- 4. Check for notices at building entrances.

**Inconveniences** caused by the work

- You will not have access to the building's main entrance for a while.
- There may be noise and dust.
- There will be workers and machinery around the building.

**Reasons** for this work

The work is required to modernize and facilitate access to the building.

The roof is worn out, so we need to replace it to prevent water leaks.

Investment: 1.2 M\$
