

- about thirty people took part in the door-to-door meetings;
- we informed you of the upcoming work;
- we approved of certain choices together:
 - exterior door colour, bay windows and window panes (light anodized aluminum/light grey);
 - landscaping of parking lot and interior courtyard: 1 dividing the parking lot from the rest of the yard with greenery, 2 parking spaces for bicycles, 3 planting containers, 4 picnic tables,
 playground with gravel and 6 playground with grass for children.

When the contractor asks, please:

- remove anything less than 3 feet (1 metre) from the exterior door and windows; follow the instructions with this RenoUpdate;
- remove everything from your balcony; follow the instructions with this RenoUpdate.
- move anything in your apartment that could get in the workers' way. They will need to enter your living room and bedrooms.

Check every day for a notice at the entrance to the building.

Check every day for a notice on your apartment door.

- The date and time of the work in your apartment will be posted on your door.
- We will notify you at least 2 days in advance.
- The work in the apartments will occur between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Please be home on the day of the work. If you cannot, ask someone you trust to be present in your apartment. This could be a neighbour, friend, or family member.

If you cannot be home and no one can be there for you, inform your liaison officer as soon as possible.

Stay outside the safety perimeter. Stay away from the site and equipment to avoid an accident.



- You will not have access to the balconies when we replace them and the outside stairs.
- There will be noise and dust.
- There will be scaffolding, workers and machinery.

Reasons for this work

The work is necessary because the roof, stairs, exterior doors and windows are worn out. Your building will be more protected against leakages. The outdoor landscaping will create better division between the parking lot and the yard. It will be safer for everyone, especially for children.

PREPARING FOR ON-SITE WORK

Your doors

When the contractor asks, you must:

- Remove everything within one metre (3 feet) of doors.











Your windows







When the contractor asks, you must:

- Remove everything within at least one metre (3 feet) of windows.
- Remove air conditioners from windows before work begins in your apartment.







PREPARING FOR ON-SITE WORK

Your balcony



When the contractor asks, you must:

- Clear everything off your balcony, including bicycles, flower pots and furniture.
