Next steps in the work

Here is where we are with the work:



Alley façade

- **1.** The work on the façade overlooking the **alley** is done.
- **2.** Work to add a sealant to the masonry is scheduled for spring-summer 2025.



Rue Lajeunesse façade

1. The work on the façade overlooking **rue Lajeunesse** is done.



Rue Jarry façade

1. The work on the façade overlooking **rue Jarry** will be done soon.



Rue Berri façade

- **1.** Work on the balconies and brick is underway in addition to replacing the kitchen windows.
- **2.** The façade will be **covered with plastic sheeting** so work can continue during the winter.

Entrance door

The entrance door to the building will be changed before the end of the work.

The opening mechanism is functional; it has been checked and refurbished.

Door opening times have been reduced to prevent intruders from entering the building.







* The contractor may need to work on Saturdays (8 a.m. to 5 p.m.). Work hours will be in accordance with the borough's rules.

Meeting on October 23:

There were 26 people in attendance.

Here is what you told us during the last consultation regarding the terrace, entrance and curb.

Terrace

- The terrace can be designed differently. We will get back to you with proposals for the layout of the space.
- You mentioned the need to make it easier for people with reduced mobility to access the terrace.
- You would like to have a spot for herbs in planters.

Building entrance

 You would like better lighting and to have the entrance roof extended (fill the empty space).

Curb (forecourt)

- One third of the alley belongs to the OMHM and could include more greenery. A proposal was made to add large flowerpots.
- Some tenants bring chairs to sit together in front of the metro. You would like to make this space more welcoming.

We'll be back to consult you before the work is carried out.

Your opinion is important so we can make sure the terrace and outdoor spaces meet your needs.



During the consultation meeting on October 23, you had some questions about security.

Here are the answers:

- The cameras at the entrance operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Currently, we pay particular attention to camera images in the evenings.
